	<b>Theme Day 1</b>	<b>Theme Day 2</b>	<b>Theme Day 3</b>
<p>Each year group to offer opportunities for food tasting, listening to French music, counting and chanting/singing the numbers and days of the week across the theme days.</p>			
<b>EYFS</b>	Work around the greetings- hello and goodbye.	Learn how to say 5 colours (red, blue, yellow, green, purple)- learn how to sing a rainbow in French and create the rainbow art pictures.	Matisse- cutting out blocks of colour.
<b>Year 1</b>	Naming body parts- learn to sing Head, Shoulders, Knees and Toes in French. Read Le Grand Monstre Vert. Art in the style of David Ferreira (the abstract human faces- not the animals).	Work around introducing yourself in French.	French Art- work in style of French artist Jeremi Ca to build on colours in French.
<b>Year 2</b>	Work around emotions in French, asking someone how they are and responding simply.	Food- learning how to say we like certain foods using: J'aime (I like) ...	French artist- Hersk.  Work to consolidate colours and food- in the style of the French pop artist.

Producing paintings of the Eiffel Tower using Pointillism in the style of Georges Seurat.</p>	<p>Talking about how old you are- work around this question and the numbers.</p>	<p>Talking about our families in French.</p>
<p>Year 4</p>	<p>Learning about the French Alps as a French region- creating landscapes in the style Paul Cezanne.</p>	<p>Work around the seasons/weather in French.</p>	<p>Learning how to talk about our clothes in French- recap of body parts.</p>
<p>Year 5</p>	<p>Matisse- recapping the colours but learning about how to say what our favourite colour is in French. Art work.</p>	<p>Directions- learning how to direct our way around Paris using directions in French. Clay Gargoyles.</p>	<p>Adjectives to describe ourselves and our family members in French.</p>
<p>Year 6</p>	<p>Animals, rooms and numbers- using the text Maman!  Animal art in the style of David Ferreira.</p>	<p>Pop art in the style of Kikayou.</p>	<p>Talking about our hobbies in French.</p>
